Meeting Summary (1/25)

This week, we heard from Dr. Tracy Paukette, a DVM from the reactive referral center. We heard from her in the fall but as a refresher, Dr. P works with reactive animals and provides general practice care. She was able to provide information on different types of reactive behaviors such as learned helplessness. We also learned displacement behaviors to understand how dogs react while under stress by displaying behaviors such as yawning, kissing, rolling over, scratching, shaking, and sniffing. Dr. P recommended recognizing these behaviors at the clinic and pointing them out to the client to provide better care for the patient. She also gave tips for the environment to limit stress such as using cleaning products with low odor, pheromones, removing animal wall art, and limiting noise. Exam room tips were also discussed such as limiting restraints and giving high rewards such as whipped cream. Our next meeting is next week, (2/15) at 8pm in KHS 1101.
