This week we heard from Darian Frost, a current Michigan State University Veterinary student. She is a second year student. She graduated from GVSU in 2017 with a BMS degree. Initially, she started in medical sales after she graduated because she was no longer interested in getting her M.D. After a few years she decided to apply to vet school instead. Starting out she had a 3.1 GPA and emphasized that grades are not everything. Also she mentioned that extracurriculars, especially outside of animal experience, are important.
