

Review of the Active Membership Point System

As stated in the constitution, members of the GVSU Pre-Veterinary Club can choose to gain active membership in order to attend club funded events like the 2018 APVMA Symposium, and the Michigan Veterinary Conference. Article 4.1.2 states that an active member is defined as a member who obtains 4 points from the three categories (**Fundraising Activity, Volunteering, and attendance at club meetings**). Additionally, the 4 points must be obtained from at least two different categories.

- All points gained Fall semester will roll over to this semester.
- Active membership is not required to be a member of the club. If you pay dues and are a member on the Org Sync page you are considered a member of the club.
- If you decide to become a active member you have the advantage of participating in club funded events because you helped raise funds for those events (APVMA Symposium and the Michigan Veterinary Conference).
